

RULES OF COMPETITION

- 1) Check in will be done on the lake, look for the Musky Mikes Signs.
- 2) All teams participating must allow an inspection of their boat and live well(s). Teams not inspected will be subject to disqualification. Cell phone numbers to judge boats will be handed out at this time.
- 3) Any contestant or boat caught breaking any State of Wisconsin fishing and boating rules, regulations and licensing during the tournament, the team will be disqualified. No reimbursement of registration fee is returned.
- 4) Cheating: if any contestant is caught cheating, it shall result in immediate disqualification of the team and forfeiture of the event entry fee.
- 5) Contestants shall conduct themselves in a courteous and sportsman-like manner at all times.
- 6) There is no rules meeting, participants are expected to read and understand the rules prior to the tournament. If you have any questions regarding the rules, you can ask at registration or during the inspection of your boat.
- 7) Tournament competition hours shall be 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on the date of the tournament. There shall be no fishing of any kind on the date of the tournament prior to tournament hours.
- 8) Boat markers will be provided by Tournament Officials and must be displayed at all times during tournament fishing hours. Markers must be returned at the end of the tournament.
- 9) Trolling is allowed, but you must stay at least 100 feet from other boats whether or not they are in the tournament.
- 10) Live bait may be used.
- 11) During tournament hours contestants must not leave the boat without checking with tournament officials at the launch site.
- 12) Musky must be at least 34 inches long in order to be eligible for measurement.
- 13) All qualifying fish will be measured and photographed by judge boats. Last call for measurement to the judge boat is 3:00 p.m. The measurements will be rounded down to the nearest 1/4 inch. Measurements can be done at any time during the day at the discretion of the teams. Any dead or severely damaged fish will be assessed a 4 inch penalty and that fish must be counted on that team's total length.
- 14) Musky Mikes Bait and Tackle LLC and tournament sponsors will not accept responsibility for damage to boats including any damage which may offer from judge boats. Protect your boat hull from scrapes and damage by having the appropriate boat bumpers.
- 15) **All fishing must stop at 3:00 p.m. or they will be disqualified. Last call for Official measurement is at 3:00 p.m.**
- 16) The team's finishing position will be determined by the total length of their largest two fish measured. If there are ties, they shall be broken as follows:
 - i) The team that caught the longest single fish receives the higher position.
 - ii) The team that submitted their entry form and fee first receives the higher position.
 - iii) If still tied, the prize money will be split between the teams.
- 17) The decision of tournament officials is final.
