

MUSKY MIKES BAIT AND TACKLE

Northern Pike Tournament

OKAUCHEE LAKE

When: August 14, 2011 (Sunday)
Where: Foolery's Liquid Therapy
Cost: \$100 a team

General Rules:

- 1) The entry fee is \$90 with a \$10 registration fee for a total of \$100.00 for each team.
- 2) The team shall consist of one or two persons and there may be no more than one team per boat. Non-team members are not allowed on the boat.
- 3) For safety purposes, all teams must have a cell phone on board.
- 4) Any contestant or boat caught breaking any State of Wisconsin fishing and boating rules, regulations and licensing during the tournament, the team will be disqualified. No reimbursement of registration fee is returned.
- 5) Cheating: if any contestant is caught cheating, it shall result in immediate disqualification of the team and forfeiture of the event entry fee.
- 6) Contestants shall conduct themselves in a courteous and sportsman-like manner at all times.
- 7) There is no rules meeting, participants are expected to read and understand the rules prior to the tournament. If you have any questions regarding the rules, you can ask at registration or during the inspection of your boat.

RULES OF COMPETITION

- 1) All teams participating must allow an inspection of their boat and live well(s).
- 2) Tournament competition hours shall be 6:45 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on the date of the tournament. There shall be no fishing of any kind on the date of the tournament prior to tournament hours.
- 3) Tournament boundaries shall be anywhere the team can access without removing their boat from the water.
- 4) Boat markers will be provided by Tournament Officials and must be displayed at all times during tournament fishing hours. Markers must be returned at the end of the tournament.
- 5) Only one fishing line per contestant is allowed in the water at any time. Trolling is allowed, but you must stay at least 100 feet from other boats whether or not they are in the tournament.
- 6) Live bait may be used.
- 7) During tournament hours contestants must not leave the boat without checking with tournament officials at the launch site.
- 8) Pike must be at least 26 inches long in order to be eligible for measurement.
- 9) The pike can be measured by the tournament official boats throughout the day until 2:00 pm otherwise they must be taken to the launch site to be measured by the tournament officials between 2:00 pm and 3:00pm. The measurements will be rounded down to the nearest 1/4 inch. Measurements can be done at any time during the day at the discretion of the teams. Any dead or severely damaged fish will be assessed a 4 inch penalty and that fish must be counted on that team's total length.
- 10) Boats must be at the launch site by 3:00 p.m. or they will be disqualified.**
- 11) The team's finishing position will be determined by the total length of their two longest fish. If there are ties, they shall be broken as follows:
 - i) The team that caught the longest single fish receives the higher position.
 - ii) The team that submitted their entry form and fee first receives the higher position.
 - iii) If still tied, the prize money will be split between the teams.

CASH AWARDS

\$90.00 of each entry fee goes to the purse for that particular tournament. Cash awards will be awarded according to one of the following percentages depending on the number of teams entered:

| No. of Teams | 1st Place | 2nd Place | 3rd Place | 4th Place |
|--------------|-----------|-----------|-----------|-----------|
| 30 or More | 55% | 25% | 15% | 5% |
| 16 to 29 | 60% | 30% | 10% | |
| 1 to 15 | 65% | 35% | | |

For example if 18 teams enter, the 2nd place cash prize would be \$486 (18 x \$90.00 x 30%)
